EDUCATION FOR VICTORY

Central's first line of offense — education! In compliance with accelerated high school and college education, Central's curriculum has been altered to include courses directly aligned with the war effort.

Pre-flight, emphasizing the fundamentals of flying, is designed primarily for America's future pilots. The introductory course combines the study of flying and actual motions of a plane. Students completing the primary course receive advanced instruction of ground training, including aero-dynamics, aviation, meteorology, and civil air regulations.

In accordance with war work throughout the country, all seniors are required to take a health or physical fitness course. ROTC and gym fulfill physical requirements for boys, while first aid, home nursing, and gym are offered to girls.

Code typing was organized at Central to teach students the Morse code, thus enabling them to fill positions in the communication system of the armed forces. Another course is aircraft assembly, taught by an instructor from the Fort Crook bomber plant. It is offered to girls planning to work at the bomber plant after graduation.

Completion of high school education is a vital prerequisite for entering the service. Consequently, graduation requirements have been lowered from thirty-two to thirty credits, enabling Central High school youth to take an active part in their country's service.






STAGE CREW


THE EAGLES GATHER

ROTC

The mission of the ROTC is to awaken in the student an appreciation of the obligations of citizenship, to help prepare him to fulfill his duties as a citizen, and to qualify him as a leader in peace or in war.

Central's ROTC regiment was inaugurated in the fall of 1937 to replace the cadet regiment organized in 1893. In the spring of 1941 a battalion was formed. Central's unit has won honor ratings for the past four years.

The battalion, commanded by a lieutenant colonel, is composed of four companies and a band. Freshmen are separated into a special battalion of three companies commanded by a major.

Most important of the activities during the school year is competition among companies. The outstanding company is chosen on the basis of points gained in inspections, battalion parades, proficiency in drill, and other general ratings.

Highlights of the year are the military ball at which the higher ranking officers are promoted; federal inspection, which determines the honor rating; and the final parade of the year at which the flag company, best platoon, and best squad are chosen and promotions for the coming year are announced.

A new feature of Omaha high school ROTC units is an all-city regiment commanded by a colonel chosen from the lieutenant colonels of the four high schools. Leading the battalions, the colonel was announced in Creighton stadium in May.


