NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society is an organization formed to honor those graduating seniors who have made outstanding records during their four years of high school work. Qualifications for membership in the organization are high scholastic achievement as well as active participation in school activities and enterprises.

Joseph G. Masters, former principal of Central High School, suggested in 1918 that a National Honor Society for high school students be organized. A constitution was drawn up by Mr. Masters and adopted by the National Association of Secondary School Principles in 1921. This is the twenty-fourth consecutive year that Central students have been elected to the society.

Membership in the organization holds special significance now during the war, when high scholarship and leadership are especially stressed. Through scholastic achievement, those students elected to the National Honor Society are demonstrating their fitness to hold positions of importance in the postwar world.

This spring a faculty committee with Mr. J. Arthur Nelson, principal, as chairman, met to elect members from the upper third of the senior class. After careful consideration of each student, the committee selected the 15 per cent who best met the qualifications of character, scholarship, leadership, and service.

During the past year, 84 new chapters have been added to the National Honor Society, making the total number of chapters 2,846. These chapters represent all forty-eight states, the District of Columbia, the Territory of Hawaii, the Canal Zone, and American schools in South America and China.

Knapple, Central's 1944 gridmen fought their way to within one-third of a game of first place in the Intercity league, a single loss to Tech keeping the Eagles out of first place. The main factor behind the great showing of the footballers was the outstanding play of all-city end John Steiner; all-state center Russ Gorman; and all-state back Bill Green, who was voted the toughest opponent of the year by the rough Lincoln Central squad. For the first time in many years the Eagles had two men elected to the all-state team.

The coming of the basketball season brought with it the most promising outlook since the famed five of 1940. However, the pre-season predictions proved to be faulty as a near veteran squad paced by high scoring Frank Slogr won but five games. On the other hand, Coach Ekfelt's grapplers lived up to all predictions as they finished the season with a clean slate, taking city and state honors.

With the coming of spring, the limelight was focused on track, with Coach "Pop" Schmidt's cindermen making a brilliant showing. A fine relay team of Don Brill, Cleveland Marshall, Aaron Dailey and Alan Thompson plus several excellent sprinters, and the good work of John Schmidt in the weights, helped the Eagles put on one of the best performances they have made in recent years.

The Purple standards were kept high in the two minor spring sports, tennis and golf. Veteran golfers Bob Knight, Bryce Crawford, and Dick Knight bolstered an excellent team, while the tennis quartet, captained by Dave Davis, presented an unusually fine record.






