JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

Founded in 1923 by J. G. Masters, former principal of Central High School, the Junior Honor Society is the highest goal for which underclassmen may strive. Its purpose is the recognition of individuality and high achievement in both scholarship and school activities, the encouragement of leadership, and the development of character.

Three chapters, Epsilon for freshmen, Delta for sophomores, and Gamma for juniors, compose the society. All underclassmen elected must have two A's and no grade below a B. If the student carries five credits, he is then allowed one C. The only requisite for membership during the freshman year is high scholarship and good character, but in the sophomore and junior years the student must show qualities of service, initiative, and leadership.

This year 260 students were elected to membership by a faculty committee under the chairmanship of Miss Pearl Judkins. Active membership ceases at the end of one year, but graduates who have belonged to the Junior Honor Society are considered honorary members.

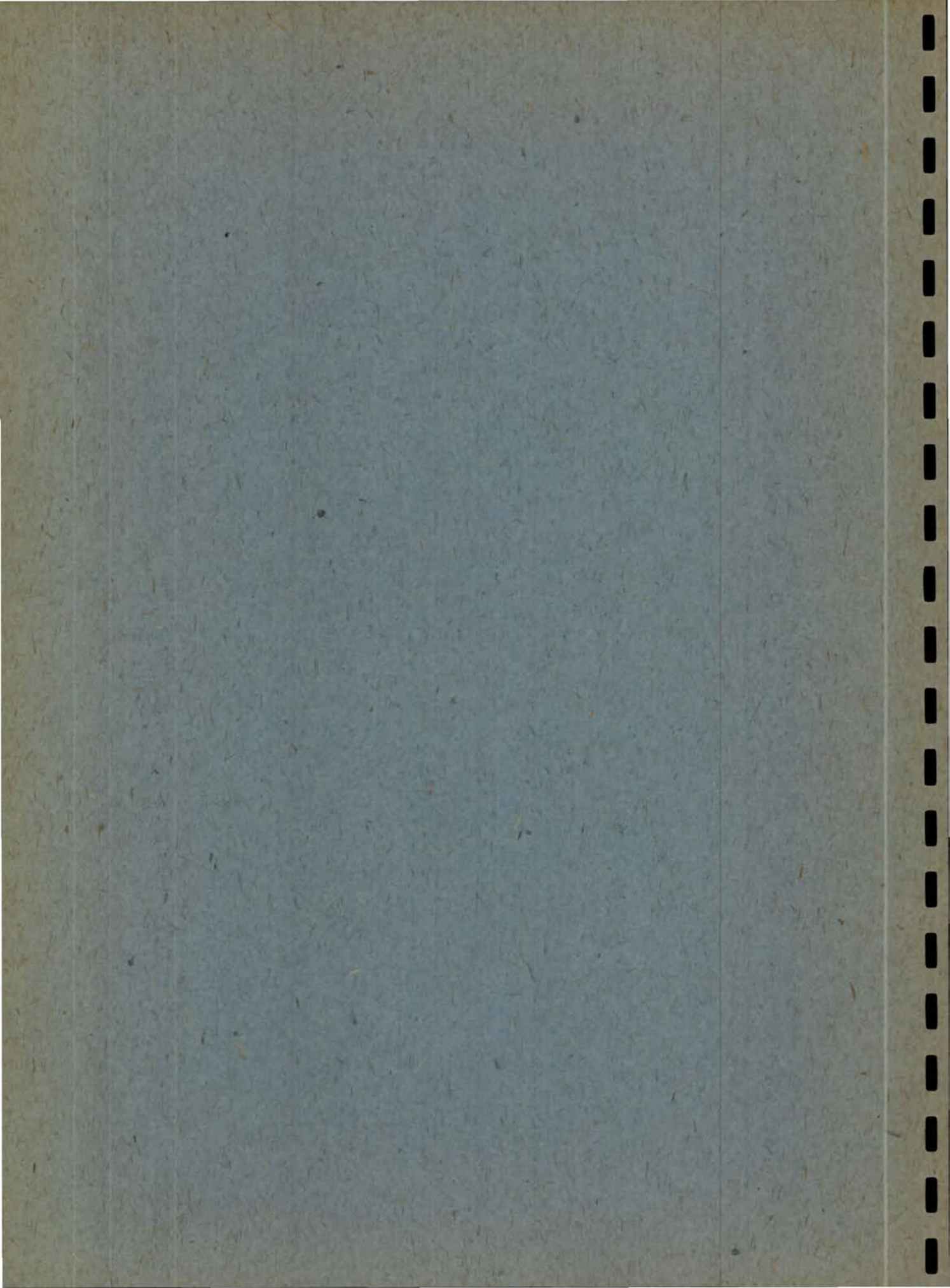

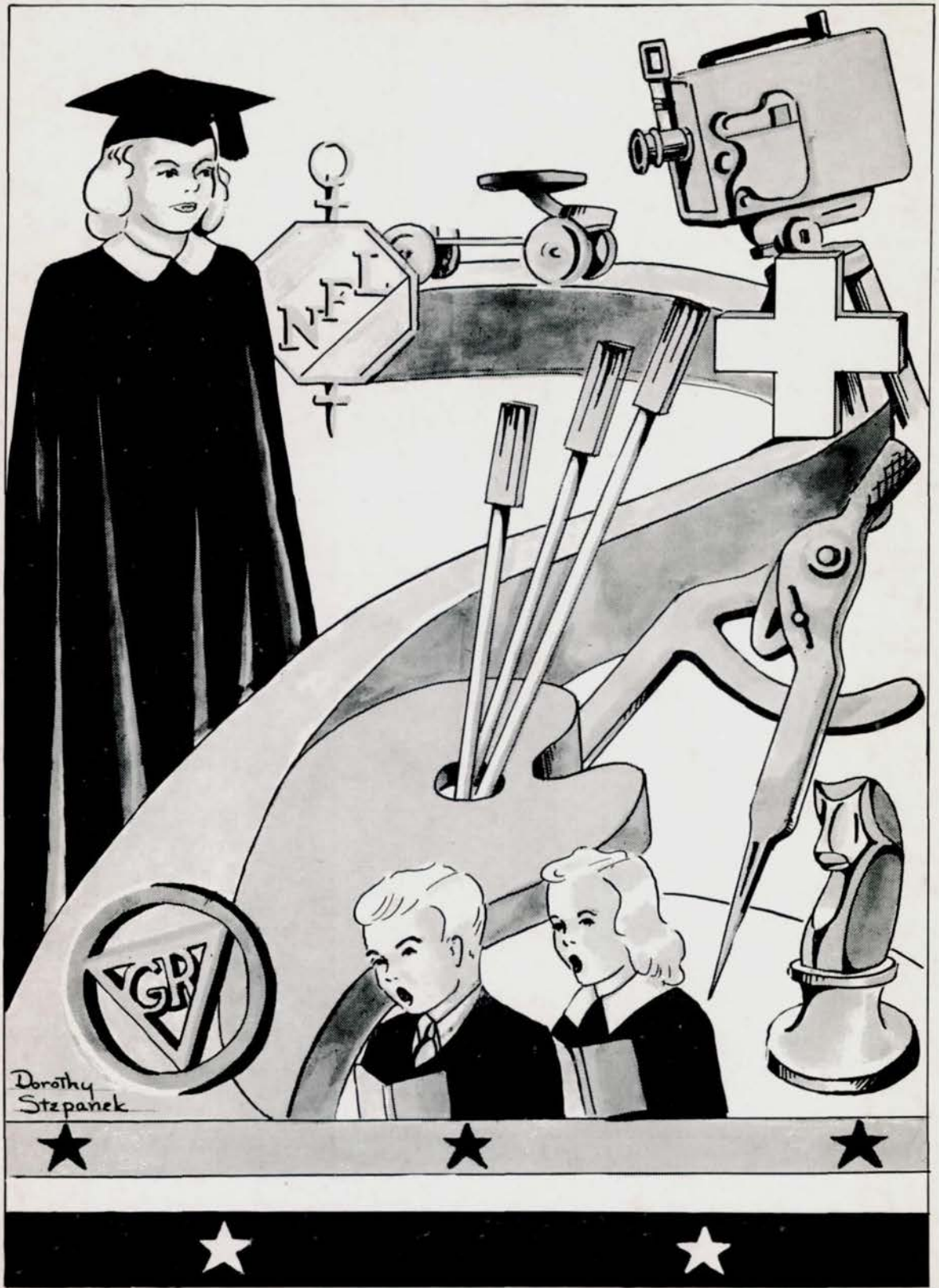

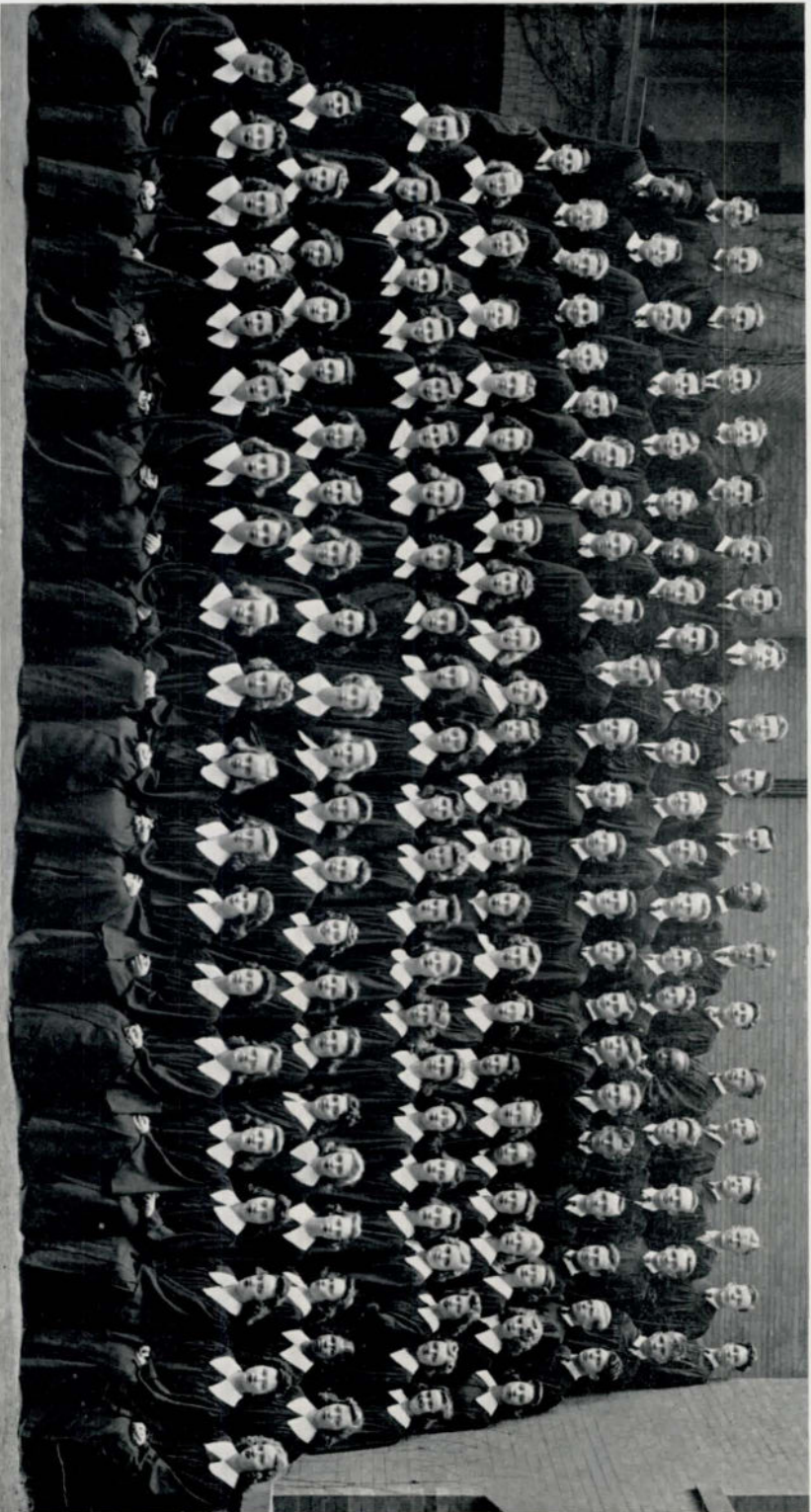

EXPRESSION DEPARTMENT

To promote interest in dramatics and to offer an opportunity for students to participate in stage activities are the main objectives of the Central High Players, under the direction of Miss Frances McChesney. 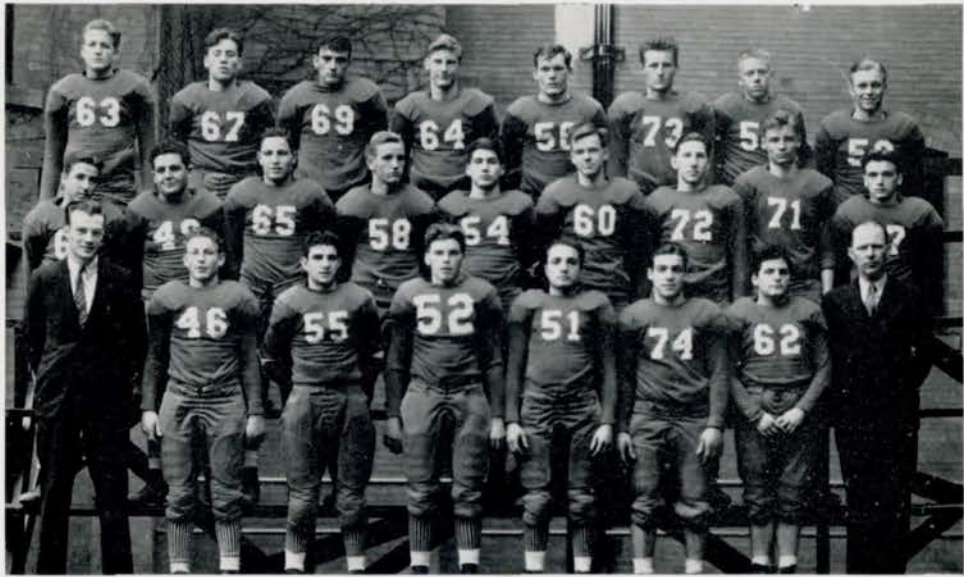

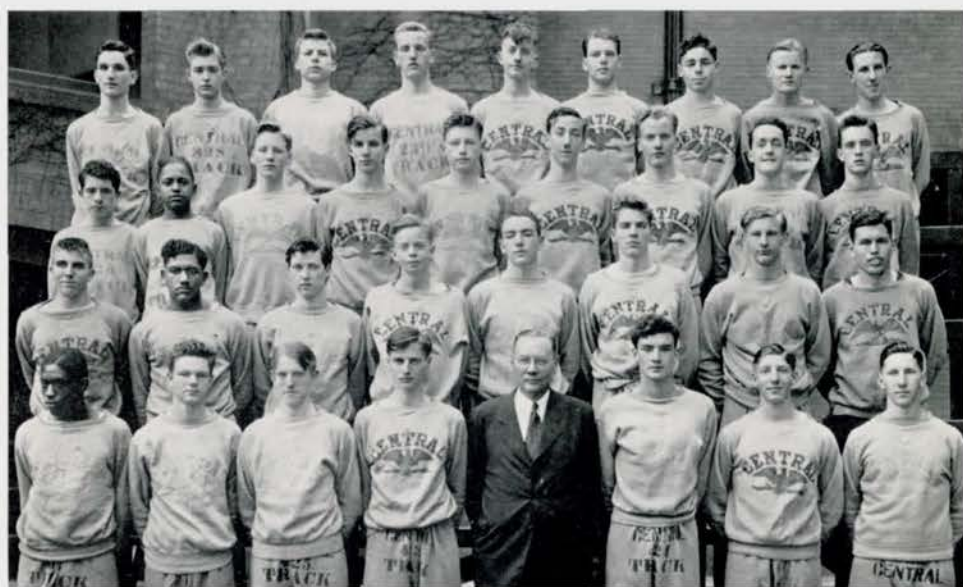

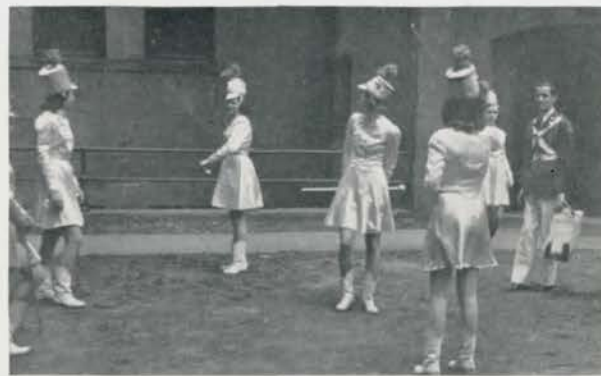
