Under the leadership of Coach Don Warner, the debate team completed another successful year by winning two trophies and three plaques.

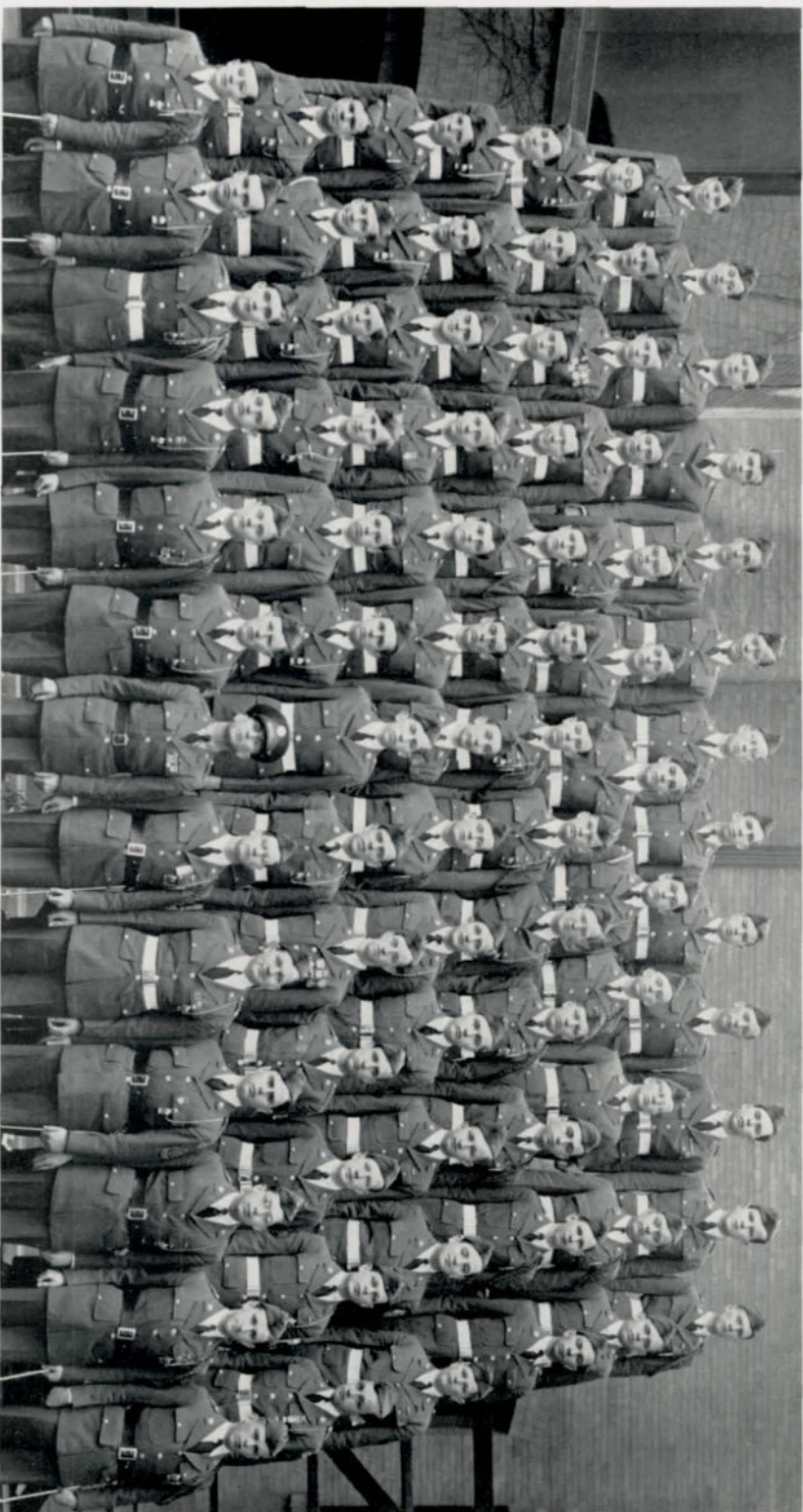

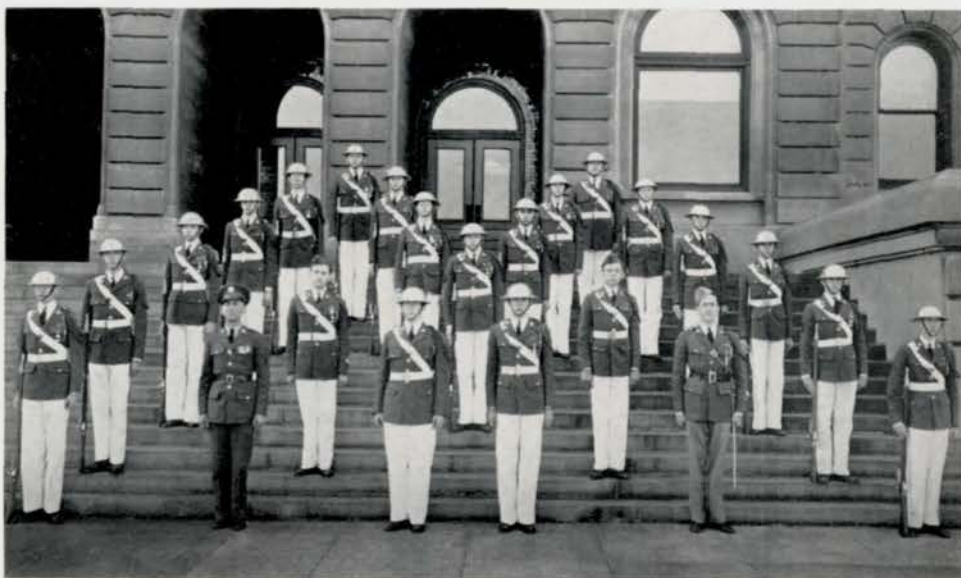

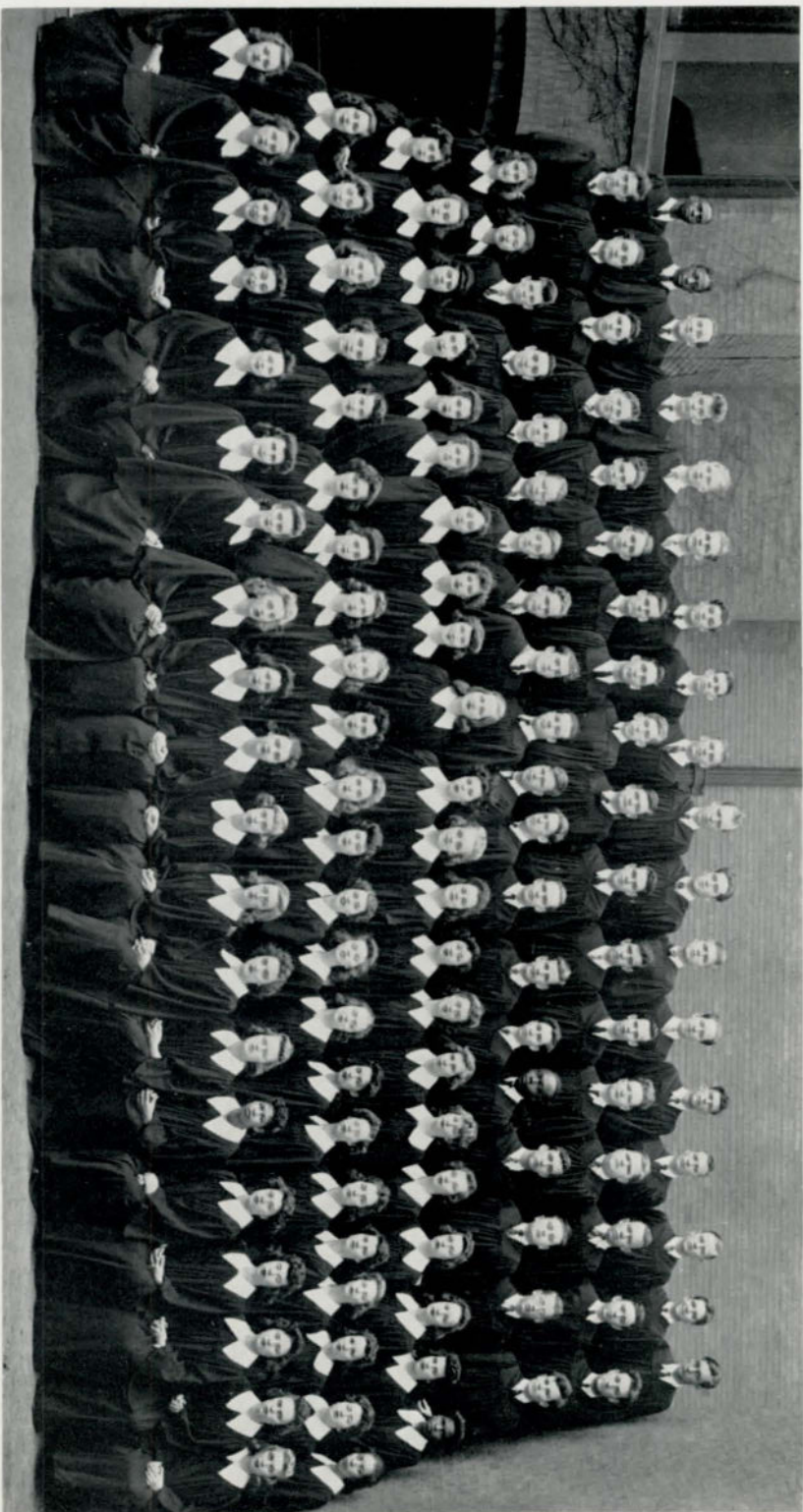

### EXPRESSION DEPARTMENT
