NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society is an organization formed to honor those graduating seniors who have outstanding scholastic records and who actively participated in school activities and enterprises during their four years of high school work.

In 1918 Joseph G. Masters, then principal of Central High school, suggested that a National Honor Society for high school students be organized. A constitution was drawn up by Mr. Masters and adopted by the National Association of Secondary School Principals in 1921. This is the twenty-sixth consecutive year that Central students have been elected to the society.

This spring a faculty committee with J. Arthur Nelson, principal, as chairman met to elect members from the upper third of the senior class. The committee selected for this honor the 15 per cent who best met the qualifications of character, scholarship, leadership, and service.

The society, now nation-wide in its scope, has nearly three thousand chapters representing all forty-eight states, the District of Columbia, the Territory of Hawaii, the Canal Zone, and American schools in South America and China.

For the second consecutive year the National Honor Society has given ten scholarships to graduating seniors throughout the country. This spring the faculty elected nine seniors who were in the upper fourth of their class to take the general aptitude test. Two of the students, Lyle McBride and John Merriam, were among the highest ranking pupils in the nation that took the examination; therefore they became eligible for the scholarship.

DEBATE

Under the leadership of Miss Verona Jerabek, coach, the debate team climaxed the season by capturing double honors—top rating at the state-wide University of Nebraska All-State Speech, Debate, and Dramatic Festival and second place at the National Forensic League tournament for 1947.

At the Nebraska Speech festival, the debate team composed of Lee Gendler, Alvin Burstein, Herbert Denenberg, and Bernard Lashinsky, won a superior rating. In individual speaking events, Carol Hill, Patricia Burkenroad, and Herbert Denenberg competed by virtue of their superior rating at the district tournament in Omaha. Superior rating went to Herbert in extemporaneous speaking, debate, and discussion.

Carol Hill won first in humorous declamation at the National Forensic League tournament. The other entries scored high points, and took second place in the sweepstakes.

The debate team also entered the Missouri Valley Boys', the Missouri Valley Open, and the Omaha University Invitational where Martin Faier and Bill Sykora had an undefeated record.

At the Sioux City Four State Speech Meet, Martin Faier won a third in oratory.

Millard Margolin took first place in the district American Legion oratorical contest and competed in the state Legion contest. He continued his winning pattern by placing first in oratory at the Northwest High School Speech Meet at Gustavus Adolphus College in St. Peter, Minnesota. The debate team, composed of Lee Gendler and Herbert Denenberg, placed third.

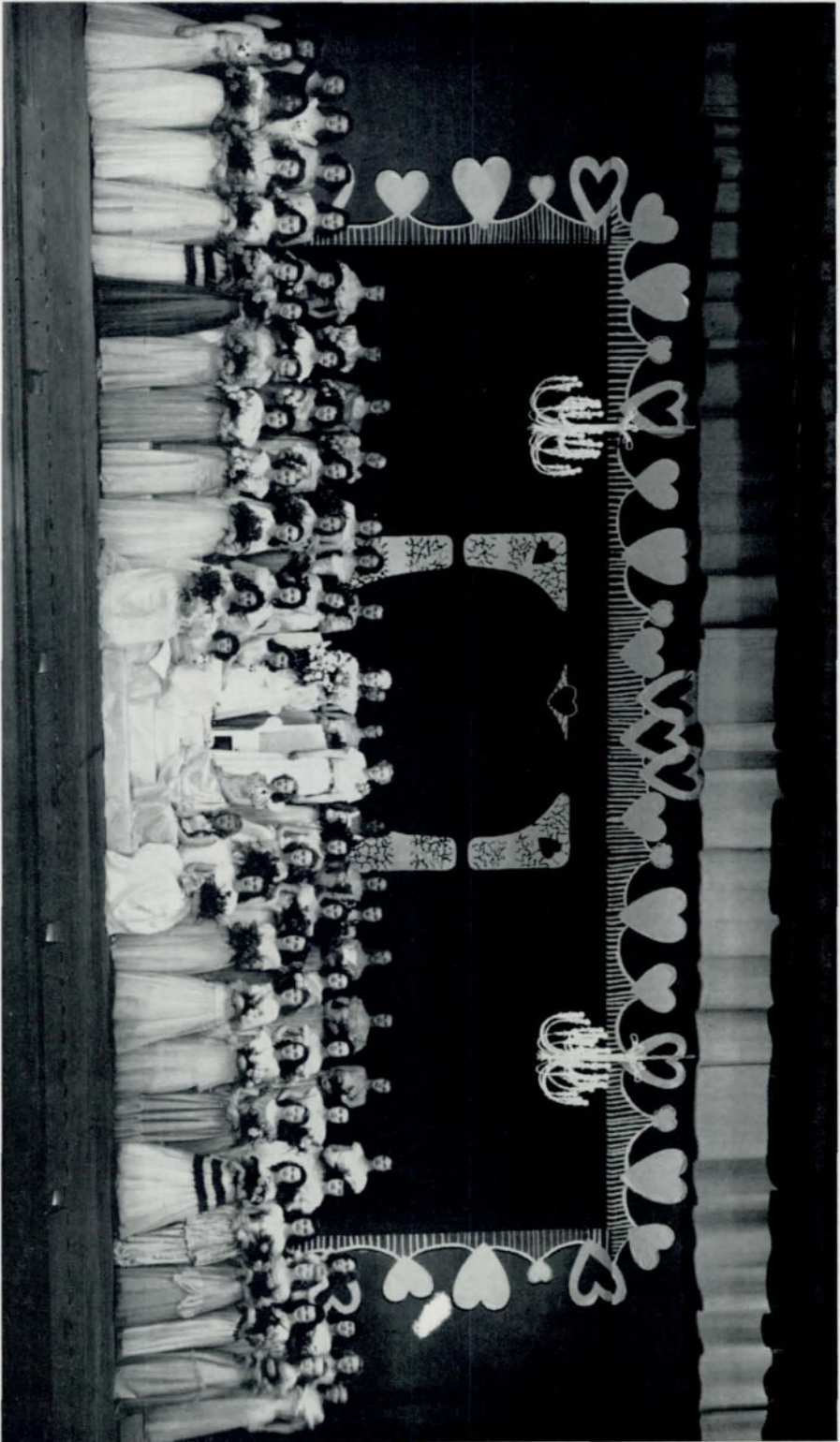

ST. VALENTINE'S BALL

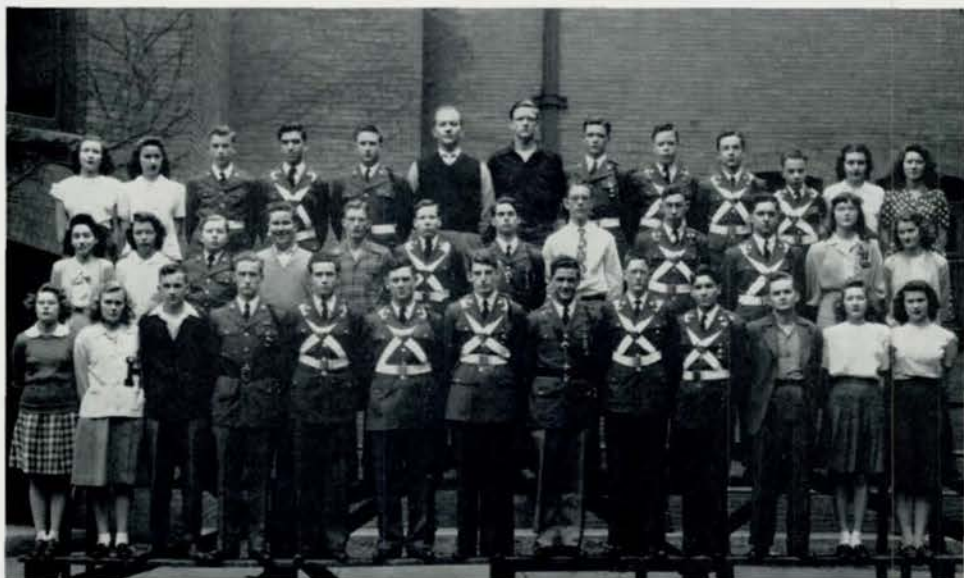

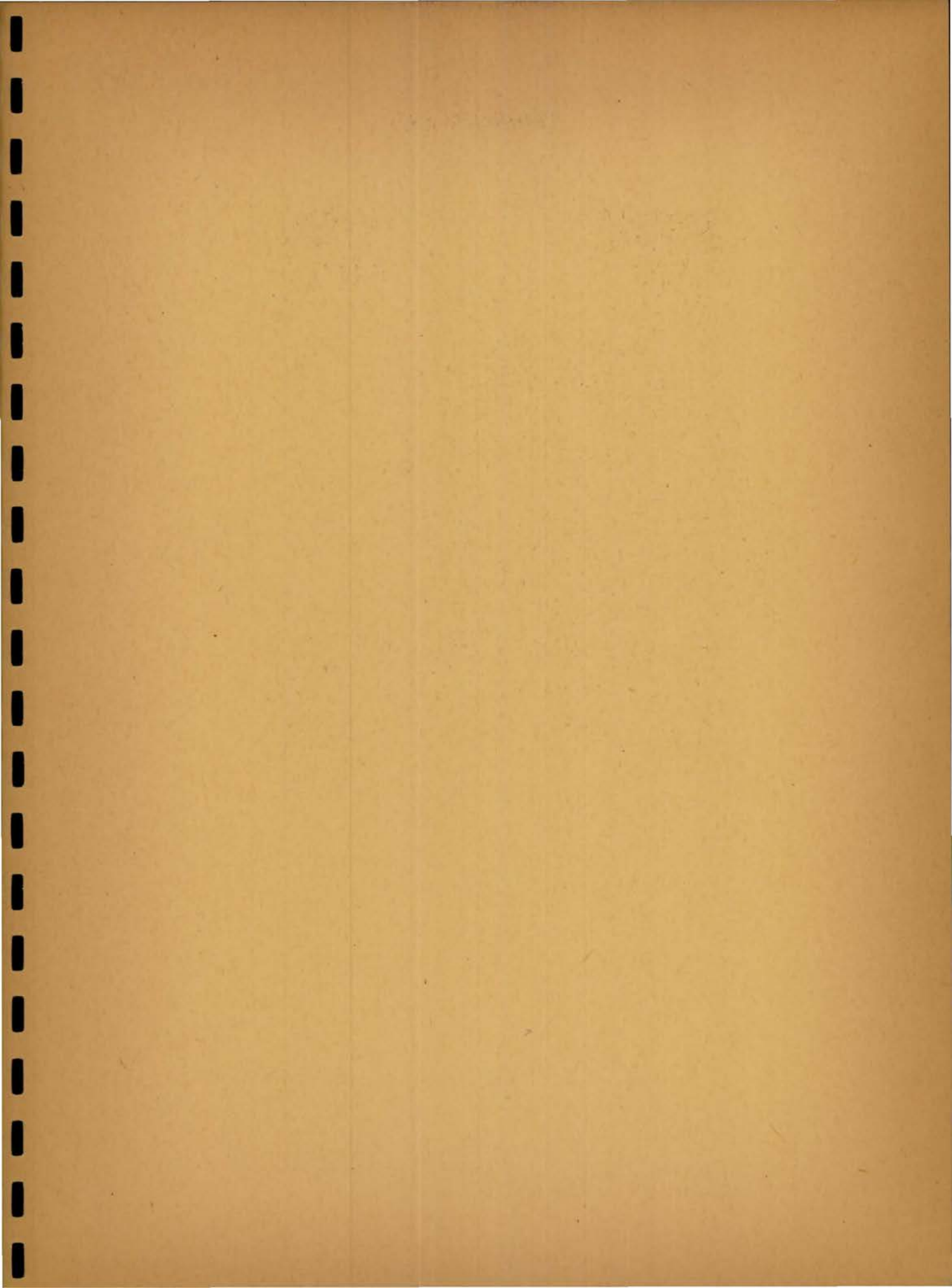
Since 1939, the Student Council, governing body of the school, has been her sponsorship.
