## THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society, first established at Central, is an organization which honors those graduating seniors who have made outstanding scholastic records and have participated actively in school enterprises during their years at Central.

Joseph G. Masters, former Central principal, drew up plans for a high school honor society in 1918. Three years later his project was accepted by the National Association of Secondary School Principals. Since then the organization has covered the United States and spread to Hawaii, Canal Zone, and American schools in China and South America.

Each spring a faculty committee with Principal J. Arthur Nelson as chairman meets to elect those seniors from the upper one-fourth of the class who are best qualified for membership in the society. This year's members were chosen from the upper quartile on the basis of character, scholarship, leadership, and service.

For the fifth consecutive year the National Honor Society has given ten scholarships to graduating seniors throughout the country. This spring the faculty elected fifteen seniors who were in the upper fourth of their class to take the general aptitude test. Barbara Findlay and Maxine Thedens were two of the highest ranking pupils in the nation to take the examination; therefore they became eligible for the scholarship.

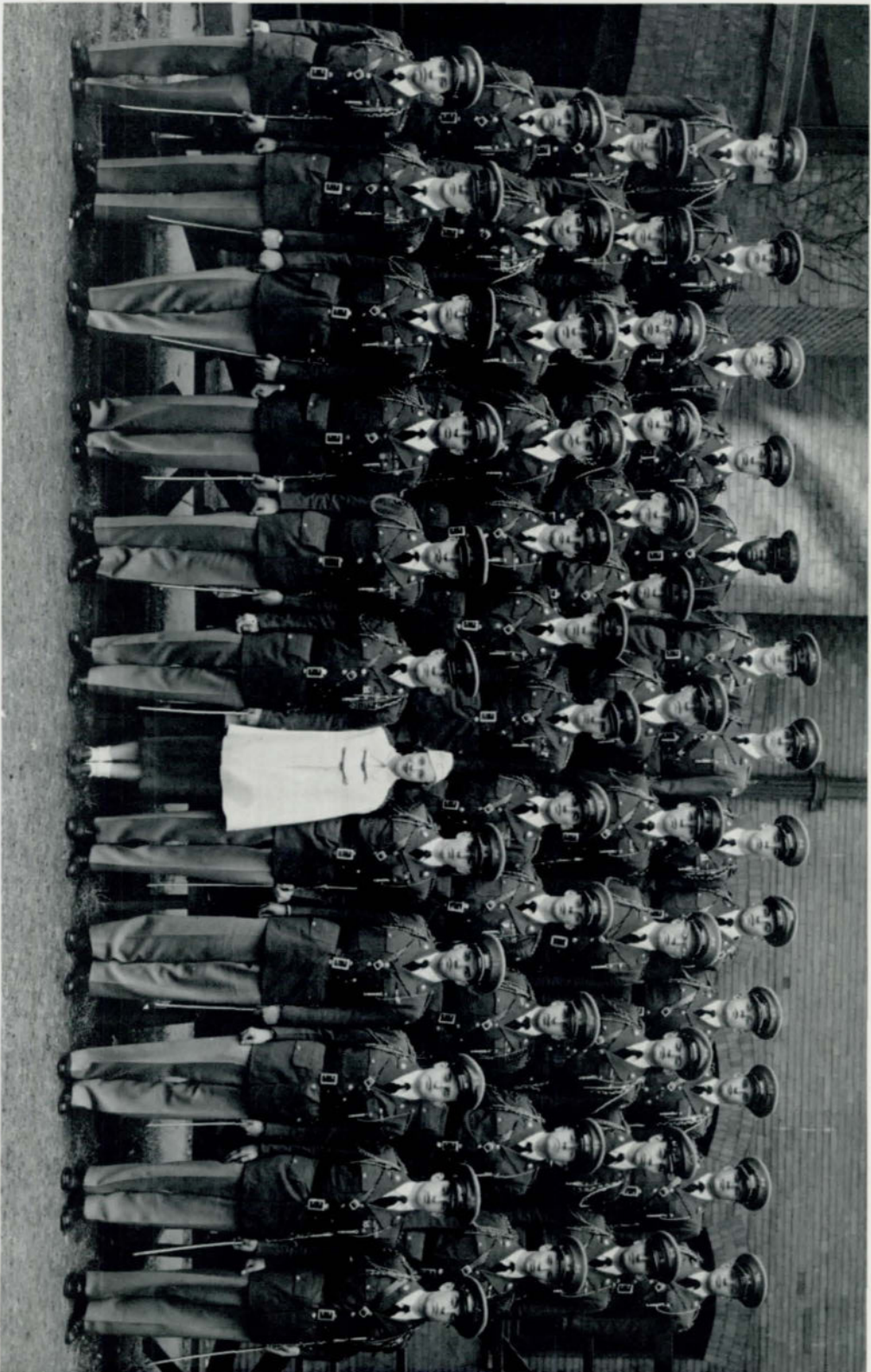

## RESERVE OFFICERS' TRAINING CORPS

The purpose of military training as stated in the Junior ROTC Manual is "to awaken in the student an appreciation of the obligations of citizenship, to help prepare him to discharge his duties as a citizen, and to qualify him as a leader, whether in peace or war."

An ROTC regiment was organized at Central High in 1937 to replace the old Central Cadet Regiment. In 1941 this unit was changed into a battalion, regimental headquarters being transferred to a city-wide basis. A new feature was inaugurated this year. The three freshman drill companies were dissolved and their members incorporated as a special battalion.

In the course of ROTC training, cadets study such subjects as close order drill, physical training, first aid, rifle marksmanship, combat principals, infantry weapons, and the National Defense Act. They are required to keep their uniforms and personal appearance always clean and neat.

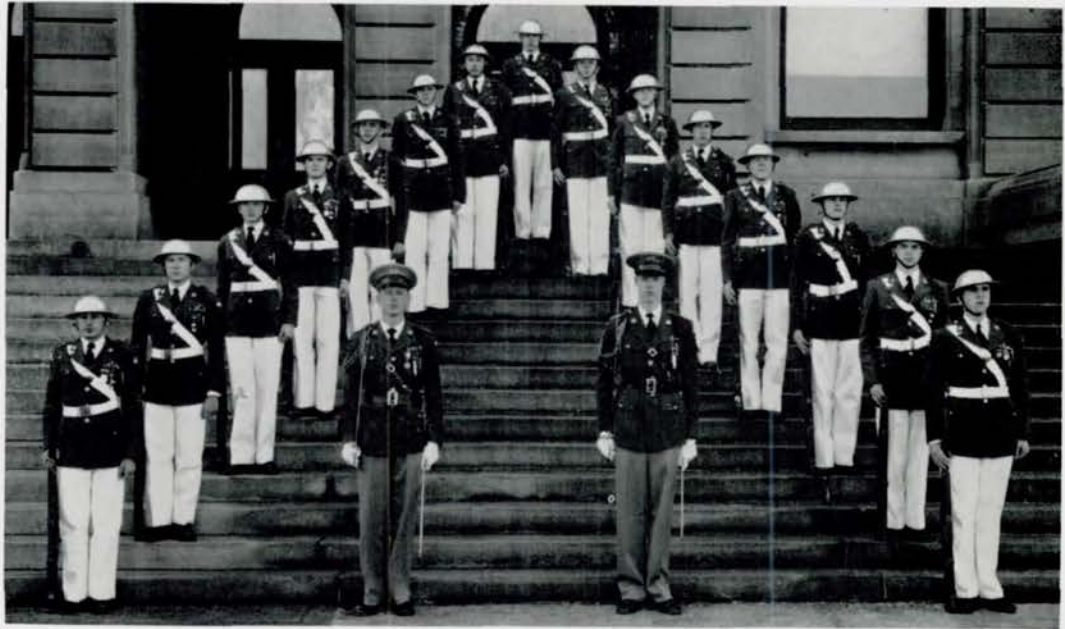
The regular battalion contains four companies plus the band. Competition is carried on among these groups throughout the year. Points are awarded on the basis of their placing first, second, or third in inspections, parades, or examinations of platoon, squad, and company proficiency in drills, spell-downs, rifle marksmanship, and general ratings. The company which gains the most points is presented with the coveted "Best Company" flag, which it carries during the following year.

The battalion and its specialized groups find time not only to participate in military and school affairs, but also to volunteer their services to civic events. Central's ROTC, outstanding in its achievements, annually wins many important awards for merit. It has earned the trophy offered each year by E. K. McDermott, prominent attorney, to the leading Omaha high school battalion, eight out of a possible twelve times.
