THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society, first established at Central, is an organization which honors those graduating seniors who have made outstanding scholastic records and have participated actively in school enterprises during their years at Central.

Joseph G. Masters, former Central Principal, drew up plans for a high school honor society in 1918. Three years later his project was accepted by the National Association of Secondary School Principals. Since then the organization has covered the United States and spread to Hawaii, Canal Zone, and American schools in China and South America.

Each spring a faculty committee with Principal J. Arthur Nelson as chairman meets to elect those seniors from the upper one-fourth of the class who are best qualified for membership in the society. This year's members were chosen from the upper quartile on the basis of character, scholarship, leadership, and service.

For the sixth consecutive year the National Honor Society has awarded scholarships to graduating seniors throughout the country. This spring the faculty elected fourteen seniors who were in the upper fourth of their class to take the general aptitude test. Of those taking the examination, Patti Gilinsky was one of the highest ranking in the nation.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC DEPARTMENT


