THE NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

The National Honor Society, first established at Central, is an organization which honors those graduating seniors who have made outstanding scholastic records and have participated actively in school enterprises during their years at Central.

Joseph G. Masters, former Central principal, drew up plans for a high school honor society in 1918. Three years later his project was accepted by the National Association of Secondary School Principals. Since then the organization has covered the United States and spread to Hawaii, Canal Zone, and American schools in China and South America.

Each spring a faculty committee with Principal J. Arthur Nelson as chairman meets to elect those seniors from the upper one-fourth of the class who are best qualified for membership in the society. This year's members were chosen from the upper quartile on the basis of character, scholarship, leadership, and service.

For the seventh consecutive year the National Honor Society has awarded scholarships to graduating seniors throughout the country. This spring, the entire upper quartile took a preliminary test, and the sixteen ranking highest took the general aptitude test.

SPORTS REVIEW

With the football squad leading off the 1951-'52 sports parade, the athletic department had little difficulty proving that sports at Central are definitely on the upward trail.

Led by Boyd Green, who garnered the All-State and All-City honors on top of being voted the "most valuable player" on the squad, and Bob Knapple, who was selected to the All-City backfield, the gridiron men managed a four win-four loss record for third place in the Intercity League. This was the best showing for the footballers since 1944, when they earned a 7-1 record.

The basketball squad won six and lost nine of their fifteen game schedule, but five of their losses were dropped by only a point or two, and the hoopsters were never really outclassed. In the city tourney, they reached the semifinals and led the city champions, Prep, almost all the way before dropping a tight match.

The wrestling squad crushed practically all their foes for another highly successful season. They were easy Missouri Valley champions but lost a rugged tournament to the South Packers in the state meet. Leonard Rosen, Mike Abboud, and Jerry Davis brought fame to the grapplers with individual state championships.

The spring sports season, although not complete when the O-Book went to press, brought even more than its share of victory headlines to the Purples. The track crew opened strong and before long had become one of the top contenders for the state crown. They polished off all comers in the Columbus Invitational, Missouri Valley, Intercity, and District meets.

The baseball and golf crews had to be satisfied with mediocre seasons but the tennis enthusiasts, led by Marshall Becker and Norman Veitzer, winners of the Missouri Valley doubles crown, looked exceptionally good.
