

Mr. James Price, station manager, and Mr. James Minear, chief engineer, teach courses on all aspects of radio broadcasting.





Central High School's Eighth Annual Homecoming Weekend was held on October 10 and 11.




William was awarded the Legion



Judy was an Eaglette her junior year and was active in the French Club and Junior Classical League.





The purpose of the institute is to give each delegate a chance to view and actually participate in the various aspects of government.




Junior Choir Members Lift Voices in Song





Central's only victory came at the


Homecoming game, where the Eagles downed A.L., 14-8.

Disappointing losses to North, Bellevue, and Prep, followed the Eagles' Homecoming victory.







Jim Crew, who was not able to play in many season matches because of football practices, teamed up with doubles partner Irv Rodin to win the state doubles crown.


Three year standouts Jim Roseman and David Slosburg aided the team greatly with their tennis skills.


Coach James Martin's cross country team placed last in the Metro Conference National Division, winning no dual meets.

With three lettermen returning next year, Coach Martin feels that they should provide a good nucleus for the team.








In the first district game, Central easily beat Bryan, 68-53. However, in the district championship game, the Eagles were upset by Boystown, ending any hopes for the state crown.












