Dismal year brightens with win over Huskies

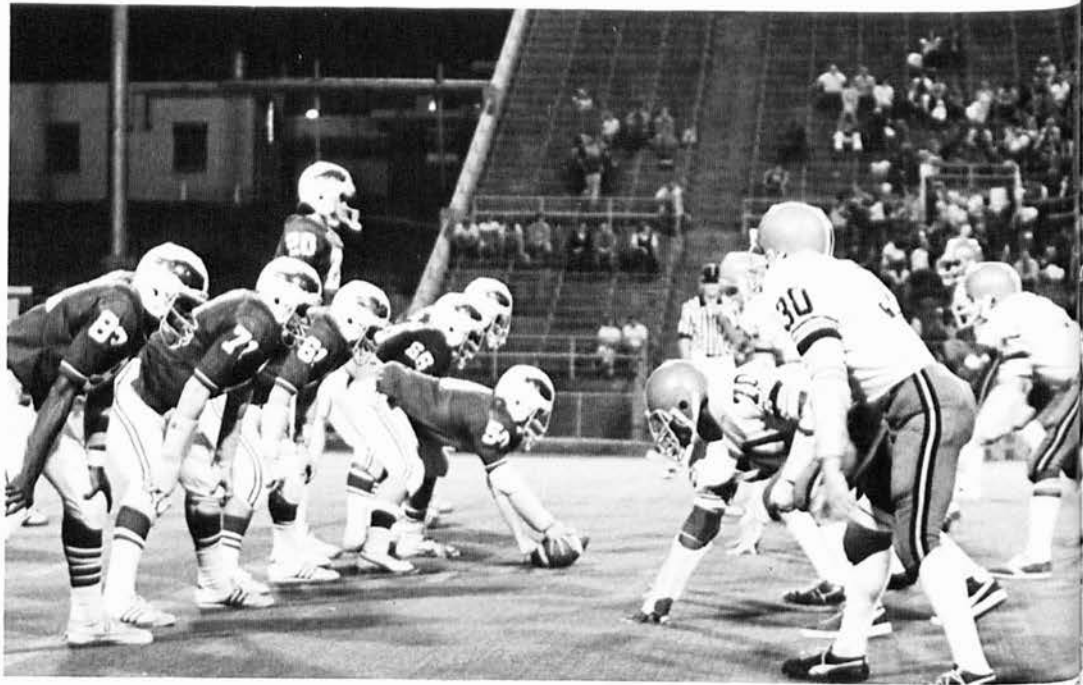
Although the varsity Eagle football team finished with a three win, six loss record, there were many highpoints throughout the season.

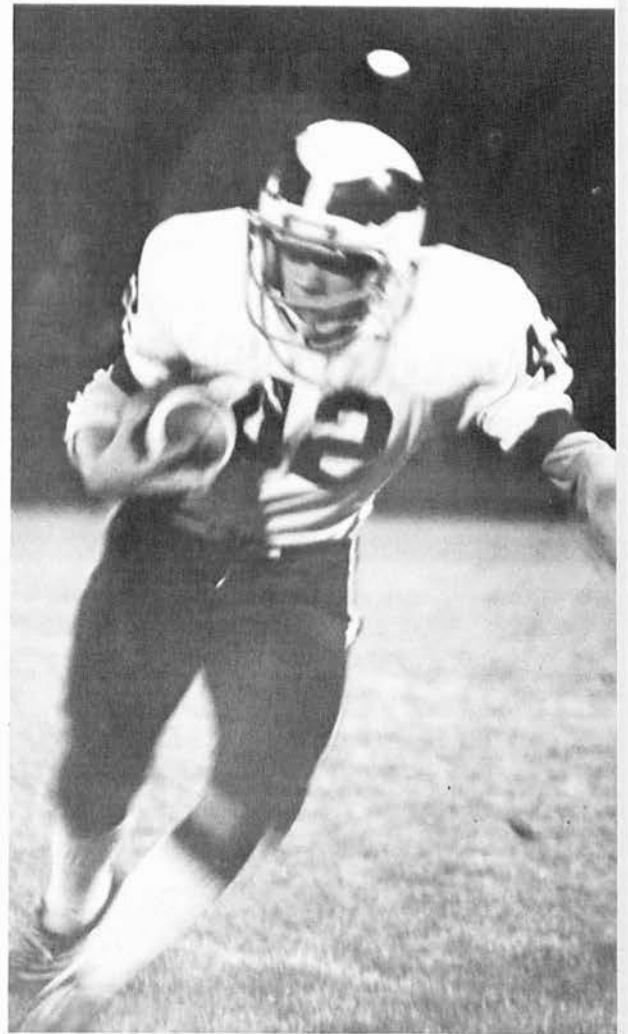

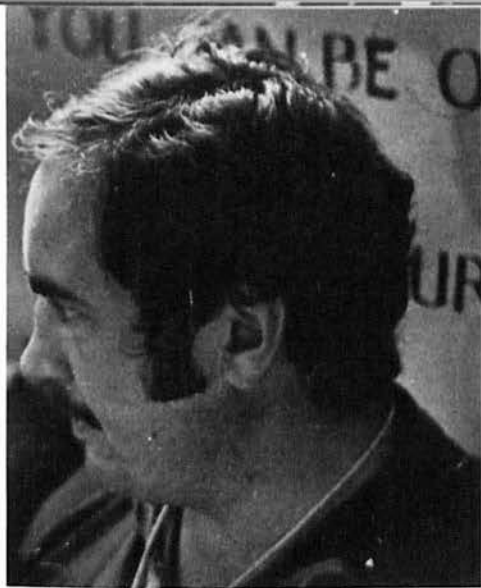


Junior Varsity suffers through losing season

Eagles' Jayvee team plays 'very good ball'

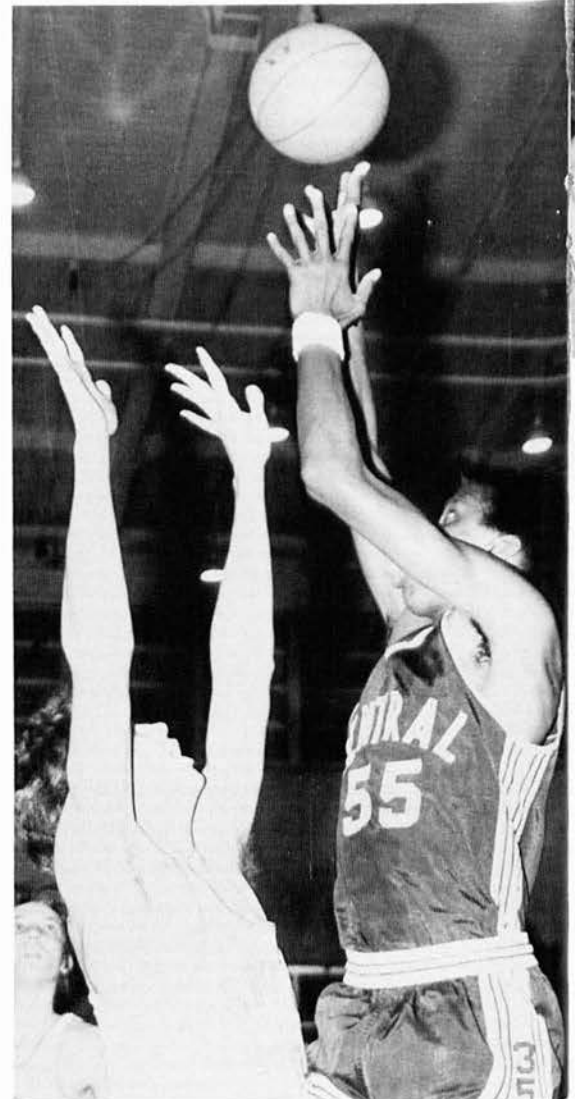
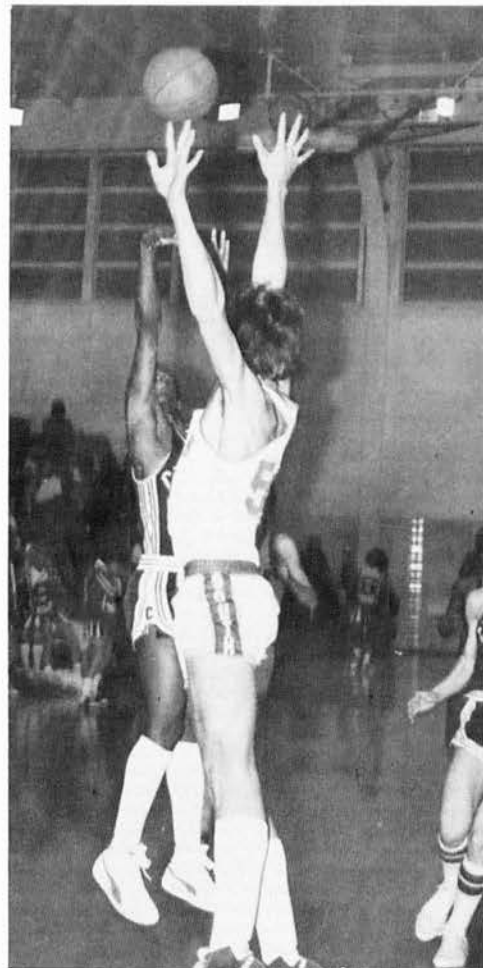
Central's J.V. basketball team earned somewhat of a winning season, and according to Coach Stan Standifer, "played very good team ball."
