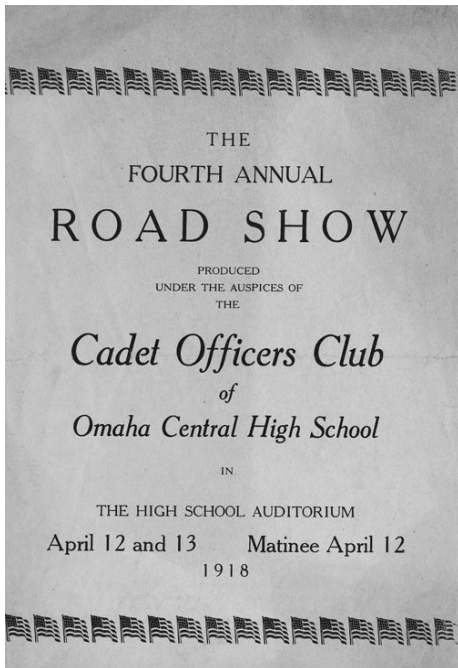

Bridging the Digital Divide

In an effort to bring Omaha Central High School into the 21st century and bridge the digital divide, the Central High School Foundation has kicked off a wireless capital campaign.

This initiative, which is chaired by [Matt '74](#) and Sheri Aden, will create a technological infrastructure to support learning at Central High School for the next 20 years, providing a 21st Century learning environment for all students at Central High School. The project includes creating wireless access points for Internet connectivity, installing hardware for instruction and presentations, and purchasing mobile computer classrooms.

Introduced in March of 2011, the initiative has already installed interactive SMART Boards in each one of Central High School's 75 classrooms this fall. Phase one will be completed over the December, 2011 holiday break. Phase one will include completing all of floors two, (Social Studies and English) and three, (Math and Science) which will cover the core subjects. Providing wireless connectivity on these two floors will also allow Central the access needed in the Spring of 2012 to prepare the students for online testing, which is the primary goal of phase one.
