Razia Jan started the Zabuli Education Center, and her work for girls in Afghanistan has made her eligible for CNN's Hero 2012 Connetition.

Razia Jan, a finalist for CNN Hero of the Year, visited Omaha for the first time and spoke with Central High School students. Central International Baccalaureate students are laying the groundwork for building a sister-school relationship with the Zabuli Education Center 30 miles outside of Kabul. The school is dedicated to the education of young women starting at age 4.

Central IB Students will interact with the students, helping them progress through their education in Afghanistan.


