Lauren Goodwillie (CHS 2013), a Syracuse University freshman who is studying this semester in Europe, traveled to the Ardennes American Military Cemetery in Belgium this November to visit the grave of Thomas Smith (CHS 1939). Smith was part of a B-24 bomber crew lost in WWII. Lauren researched his biography for AP US History her senior year. She also found Robert Marcum's grave (CHS 1940) in the same cemetery. He also was part of a bomber crew (B-17) shot down over Europe in WWII.

"It was what you'd call an 'ordeal' to get there," said Lauren. "I'm really glad I went though. It was important to me to go."
