Central students get a lesson in what life was like after the United States abolished slavery.






Join us for our Rock the Nest Trivia Challenge as we play an interactive trivia contest to raise money, to help Central High School!



Douglas Blackmon, Pulitzer Prize winning author, gave a presentation to the students of Central High School on Friday, February 1, 2013 to kick off Black History Month. Blackmon's presentation, based on his award winning book "Slavery by Another Name," reveals the lost story of slaves who ventured into freedom after the Civil War only to be forced back into involuntary servitude through the Convict Lease program implemented by many southern penal systems throughout the first half of the 20th century.


Blackmon gave a sobering and moving account of this little-known crime against American citizens. His presentation was sponsored by the Center for Faith Studies, The Central High School Foundation, the Omaha Public Schools Library Services and the Great Plains chapter of the ADL.
