Expanding their Knowledge of Religion

CHS students had the opportunity to visit the Hindu Temple of Nebraska as part of their Introduction to World Religions Class



The Introduction to World Religions classes took their last field trip of the semester to the Hindu Temple of Nebraska.

The course is a one semester Social Studies elective that focuses on an academic, neutral study of the history and theology of the world's major belief systems. Students investigate the role of religion in society, then move on to study Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism and Buddhism.

The classroom instruction is supplemented by visits to Temple Israel Synagogue, St. Nicholas Serbian Orthodox Church, the Islamic Center of Omaha and the Hindu Temple of Nebraska.

Currently Omaha Central High is the only OPS high school to offer the course.
