CHS Invitational Track Meet now known as Jo Dusatko Invitational

Thank you, Jo Dusatko, for 33 years of dedication to Central High School!



The Central Invitational track meet will now be known as the Jo Dusatko Invitational

Jo Dusatko dedicated 33 years to Central High School (1967 - 2000). Ms. Dusatko was a pioneer, and she worked tirelessly for the benefit girls sports at Central. Jo was CHS's first girls track coach in 1971, and continued as the team's coach until 1986. Her track teams won the state championship seven times, came in second five times, and went undefeated for six seasons

Under Dusatko's direction, the Central pom squad was established in 1968. Girls golf began in 1971 and Jo was the first coach. She was also the first girls soccer coach in 1986. The Nebraska Coaches Association recognized Jo as track coach of the year in 1979, 1980, and 1981. She was declared the overall girls coach of the year in 1984. Jo Dusatko was inducted into the Nebraska Sports Hall of

Dusatko was honored at the 2014 Central High School Invitational track meet on April 17.


