

## Honors US History Students Given Books about WWI

Honors US History students pose with signed copies of the new books, donated to the school by the Lebens Family.



Honors US History classes excitedly pose with copies of new books donated to them by Mike and Susan Lebens, CHS 1970. The book is titled "Poilu: The World War I Notebooks of Corporal Louis Barthas, Barrelmaker, 1914-1918" by Louis Barthas, translated by Edward Strauss.

The books are signed by the translator and will be studied by 37 Honors History students prior to a special WWII tour of Europe they are taking this summer.

The book, published by Yale Press, is available for the first time in English this year. Barthas's notebooks - 19 in total - transcribed the larger story of the unnumbered soldiers who fought in World War I.


