TAGG offers a smartphone app, that when used at 120 participating local businesses, the business will donate 5% of your purchase, any day any time! The app, available on iPhone and Android devices, is free to download and easy to setup. Here's how to get started:

- 1) Download the free app 'Together A Greater Good' to your iPhone or Android device
- 2) When it's time to pay at a participating business, click the orange 'TAGG My Purchase' button on the app, and tell the cashier you want to TAGG.
- 3) Enter in the total pre-tax amount of your purchase and click 'Next'.
- 4) Your camera should appear and the cashier will provide you with an orange QR card to scan.
- 5) Choose Central High School Foundation from the list of organizations.

Two Central alums are making big splashes down Dodge Street at UNO. Tra-Deon Hollins, a 2013 graduate of CHS, transferred from Central Community College in Columbus, Nebraska, to join a UNO program that is gaining traction as it completes the transition to Division I. He helped lead the Eagles to four consecutive Class A State Championships from 2010 to 2013.

Teammate Tre'Shawn Thurman, a 2014 graduate of Central, also will be an important part of the Mav's plans this season.

On the young season, Hollins is among the best in the nation in steals per game, averaging almost four swipes per game. Thurman is also playing very well, averaging almost 14 points per contest.
