The Inaugural Baxter Roundball Rivals Series featured two games, a Pre-Game Alumni Party, which entertained over 800 alumni, and a half-time ceremony honoring state basketball championship teams of the 1970's and 1980's. Over 50 player and coach honorees attended the game. The basketball game was played in front of a crowd of 3,471. This was the largest crowd during the 2014-15 regular season and the largest crowd to watch a basketball game in Ralston Arena history. Marian and Central girls squared off in the first game, and Creighton Prep and Central tipped off for the nightcap. The Lady Eagles beat the Marian Crusaders 60-53, and the Creighton Blue Jays beat the Central Eagles 67-60.
