The Eagles (18-6), as the number seven seed, open the tournament against the number two seed, Creighton Prep (23-3) on Thursday, March 10, 2016, at 7 p.m. at the Pinnacle Bank Arena. # Alumni Spotlight: Rosen Brothers Still Competing in Track & Field



Two athletes, formerly from Omaha, are still competing in senior track and field. Leonard (Len) Rosen and Alan Rosen are both over 80 years old and still competing in the discus and shot put. Born in Omaha, both men attended Dundee Grade School and graduated from Central High School. Both men lettered in football, wrestling, and track and field while donning the purple and white for Central, and both were awarded the Pop Schmidt Trophy for being the most outstanding senior

Len Rosen, CHS '52 track man. The only other brothers who were awarded the Pop Schmidt Trophy while at Central were Roger

Alan Rosen, CHS '54

Sayers in 1959 and Gale Sayers in 1961. Len was introduced into the CHS Hall of Fame in 2012.

Len and Alan achieved All American status on numerous occasions while competing in senior track and field. Len won the nationals in both the discus and shot put in 2014. Len is retired and lives in Salem, NH, while Alan is semi-retired and lives in Sherman Oaks, CA. Both return to Lincoln (and Omaha) at least once a year to attend a UNL football game.

Congratulations to both Len and Alan for continuing to excel in the shot put and discus!
